

# 10 Days 7 Nights (10ECS)

## Irresistible Croatia & Slovenia



### Day 1~ Kota Kinabalu - Ljubljana (Meals On board)

- Troop down to KKIA for your flight to Zagreb.

### Day 2~ Arrive Zagreb - Ljubljana (Lunch/Dinner)

- Tour starts from Zagreb Cathedral. Its twin spires can be seen from many parts of the city, make it the most visited attraction in Zagreb.
- Walk through the Stone Gate to visit St Mark's Square, St Mark's Cathedral and Parliament building.
- Visit Ban Jelacic Square.
- Upon arrival at Ljubljana, take a funicular ride up to the Castle Hill to visit Ljubljana Castle for a gorgeous view of the city.

### Day 3~ Ljubljana – Bled - Postojna Caves - Opatija (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)



- Transfer to Bled and visit Bled Castle, which stands above the Bled Lake on the north shore.
- Enjoy a pleasant 'Pletna' traditional wooden boat ride as you across the lake to the island situated in the middle to visit St Mary Church.
- Visit Slovenia's Postojna Caves.
- Take a ride on a cave train to marvel at the size and splendor of this glorious underground world.
- Entrance to Predjama Castle, which Guinness World Record as the largest cave castle in the world.

### Day 4~ Opatija - Porec - Motovun - Rovinj - Opatija (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)



- Visit Euphrasian Basilica in Porec, a UNESCO World Heritage Site in this little town on the Adriatic Coast.
- Tour around medieval town in Central Istria, Motovun which is located on a hill 270 metres above sea level with houses scattered all over the hill.
- Proceed to Rovinj to visit St Euphemia's Basilica, a Venetian Baroque building restored between the 1725 and 1736.

### Day 5 ~ Opatija - Plitvice Lakes National Park - Zadar (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)



- Get ready for a change of scene as you approach Plitvice Lakes National Park, one of Europe's most impressive national parks with a designated UNESCO World Heritage status since 1979. Hold your breath as you walk towards the 70-metre tall Veliki Slap, the largest waterfall in the park. The beauty of the park lies in its 16 crystalline lakes, interconnected by a series of cascades, and set in deep woodland populated by deer, bears, wolves, boars and rare bird species.
- Continue journey to Zadar.

### Day 6~ Zadar - Sibenik - Split (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Take a walking tour around the Old City. Photo stop at the Church of St. Donatus,

Square of Five Wells, the Sea Organ and the City Walls and Gates of Zadar.

- Entrance to Cathedral of St. James in Sibenik, the most important architectural monument of the Renaissance in the entire country.
- Photo stop at Primosten en route to Split.
- Transfer to Split, the busiest port and largest city on the Adriatic Coast.
- Entrance to the Diocletian's Palace, one of the best preserved Roman remains in the world. Enjoy sights such as the Golden and Silver Gates, Jupiter's Temple and the Cathedral.
- Take a walking tour around the Old Town area.

### Day 7~ Split - Mostar - Dubrovnik (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Transfer to Mostar in the morning.
- Visit the 16th-century Stari Most "old bridge" built by the Ottoman Empire and reconstructed after it was destroyed during the Bosnian war.
- Visit a Turkish house and Mosque.
- Continue journey to Dubrovnik, an UNESCO heritage town.

### Day 8~ Dubrovnik - Ston - Sarajevo (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Take a walking tour of the old town. Includes viewing the Bell Tower Clock, Orlando's Column, Onofrio's Fountains and Sponza Palace.
- Visit Franciscan Monastery.
- Take a cable car up to the Mount Srd for beautiful view on panoramic views of Dubrovnik and surrounding islands.
- Enjoy some wine and oyster tasting in Ston.
- Proceed to Sarajevo, the capital of Bosnia & Herzegovina.

### Day 9~ Sarajevo – Transit City (Breakfast/Lunch)

- Visit Bascarsija and old bazaar as you discover the historical city.
- View of Gazi Husrev-Bey's Mosque, Old Orthodox Church and Latin Cuprija bridge.
- After lunch, transfer to airport for departure flight.

### Day 10~ TRANSIT CITY / KOTA KINABALU

- Arrive home with sweet memories
